2	15:05 - 15:30	<ul> <li>Funding - Several grant applications in various submission stages, which mainly concern research projects.</li> <li>ESRC have invited us to discuss how OpenSAFELY's infrastructure could be applied across new data sources, such as retail data, as part of the Smart Data Research UK Programme.</li> <li>We have been invited to apply for a Wellcome Trust Discretionary Award to support development of OpenSAFELY's infrastructure, and potential expansion into new sectors.</li> <li>One of our researchers has been awarded the NIHR's pre-application support.</li> <li>Staffing - A Senior IG Manager, Project Support Administrator, and a Communication Lead for Bennett Institute have been hired.</li> <li>Two senior Project Managers and a PPIE lead have been appointed, and will join during the summer.</li> <li>The first round of recruitment for new Researchers has been completed. Three positions were originally advertised, but four offers were made due to the strong calibre of applicants</li> </ul>	Ben

		<ul> <li>The Tech Team has advertised seven new posts and interviews are being scheduled.</li> <li>Once the current round of recruitment is complete, the team will expand to around 60 staff.</li> <li>Outputs - Two in pre-print and six newly published.</li> <li>Five new projects have been approved by NHSE.</li> <li>Tech - Preparation work has been carried out to support the expected range of research projects.</li> <li>AirLock - the tooling Output Checkers use - is now fully operational and in the process of being adopted. A demonstration will be given to this group once the tool is launched.</li> <li>Conference - The annual Bennett Institute conference will be held in London in November, and invites will be sent out shortly.</li> <li>The event will be focused specifically on OpenSAFELY, and will showcase the work of our users, with workshops/teachings focused on OpenSAFELY functionality.</li> </ul>	
3	15:30 - 15:55	<ul> <li>Governance Board - invitations have now gone to those who will oversee the NHSE contract.</li> <li>Legal basis for Non-Covid research - A draft of the new Direction has been reviewed and commented on by key individuals including: Joint GPIT, National Data Guardian, and the Department of Health and Social Care</li> <li>Current discussions centre on how the Direction will operate and how the OpenSAFELY service could be used for GP and other linked NHS datasets.</li> <li>Opening for new projects - The documentation concerning the Data Processing Agreements with TPP is close to being signed. The EMIS contractual documentation is likely to take longer to conclude.</li> </ul>	NHSE
